Sermon Title: “TIME AFTER TIME.”

Call To Worship

Leader: Time is part of God’s creation and every moment is under His authorship. Time became because God spoke it into existence. “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth ... And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light. ... and he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light “day,” and the darkness he called “night.”
Genesis 1:1-5

Congregation: "Time waits for no one" — but every moment waits on God. He writes the seasons, governs the timelines. His faithfulness, grace and mercy move beyond what our hearts and minds can ever imagine.

Ps 90:2-4; Eccl 3:1; Isa 46:10; Eph 3:20-21

ALL: God’s timing is sovereign, His mercies are new every morning — but today, if you hear His voice calling, do not harden your heart. God is calling all men and women everywhere to repent. This moment... this day... is the day of salvation. AMEN. *Lam 3:22-23; Heb 3:15; 2 Cor 6:2*



Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 9:23-28 (NIV)

Leader: 23 You made their children as numerous as the stars in the sky, and you brought them into the land that you told their parents to enter and possess. **24** Their children went in and took possession of the land. You subdued before them the Canaanites, who lived in the land; you gave the Canaanites into their hands, along with their kings and the peoples of the land, to deal with them as they pleased.

Congregation: 25 They captured fortified cities and fertile land; they took possession of houses filled with all kinds of good things, wells already dug, vineyards, olive groves and fruit trees in abundance. They ate to the full and were well-nourished; they reveled in your great goodness.

Leader: 26 “But they were disobedient and rebelled against you; they turned their backs on your law. They killed your prophets, who had warned them in order to turn them back to you; they committed awful blasphemies.

Congregation: 27 So you delivered them into the hands of their enemies, who oppressed them. But when they were oppressed they cried out to you. From heaven you heard them, and in your great compassion you gave them deliverers, who rescued them from the hand of their enemies.

ALL: 28 “But as soon as they were at rest, they again did what was evil in your sight. Then you abandoned them to the hand of their enemies so that they ruled over them. And when they cried out to you again, you heard from heaven, and in your compassion you delivered them time after time. AMEN.
