Sermon Title:

"THE MORALITY OF MONSTERS."

Call To Worship

Leader: We are truly living in a time where wickedness has no code—where truth is ignored and moral boundaries mean nothing. Let us pray that the Lord opens closed eyes and closed minds to His truth. Sharpen our discernment so we can distinguish truth from deception, fruit from façade, and righteousness from performance. *Isa 5:20; Eph 1:18; Heb 5:14*

Congregation: Scripture provides us with the formula to navigate through all the deception, nonsense and pure evil. “Try the spirit by the Spirit,” examine the type of fruit that is being produced. For the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. *1 John 4:1; Gal 5:22–23*

ALL: May a holy conviction rest on us, giving us the courage to walk in integrity, bear righteous fruit, and stand firm against every hidden work of darkness that disguises itself as something good. For the Word reminds us that “the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness, and truth.” AMEN.

Scripture Lesson/Reading: Matthew 7:15-20 (NIV)

Leader: **15** “Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. **16** By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?

Congregation: **17** Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. **18** A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit.

ALL: **19** Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. **20** Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them. AMEN.
