"DON'T GIVE UP."

Call To Worship

Leader: Scripture calls us to stand firmly, stay spiritually alert, and resist the enemy's schemes. When we walk in obedience, we don't just endure, we position ourselves to receive divine blessing, supernatural timing, and renewal. *Eph 6:11-13; 1 Pet 5:8-9; Deut 28:1-2*

Congregation: Let us lift one another up—encouraging each other to stay spiritually alert and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus. Hold fast to our faith—because the joy of the Lord is our strength, our anchor and our victory is already in motion. *Heb 12:2; Neh 8:10; Isa 40:31*

ALL: As we walk through the storms of this life, let us remember: God's faithfulness never fails. We can trust Him—for deliverance, for restoration, and for every promise yet to be fulfilled. "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful." *Heb 10:23; Gal 6:9 AMEN.*

Scripture Lesson: *Amos 9:11-15 (NIV)*

Leader: **11** "In that day "I will restore David's fallen shelter— I will repair its broken walls and restore its ruins—and will rebuild it as it used to be, **12** so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name," declares the Lord, who will do these things.

Congregation: **13** "The days are coming," declares the Lord, "when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman and the planter by the one treading grapes. New wine will drip from the mountains and flow from all the hills,

ALL: **14** and I will bring my people Israel back from exile. "They will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit. **15** I will plant Israel in their own land, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them," says the Lord your God. AMEN.
