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Sermon Title: "TOMORROW PLEASE HURRY."

Call To Worship

Leader: In moments of urgency, when our hearts cry out for God’s intervention, let us pause and lift our voices in praise and worship. Through reverence, gratitude, and trust, we position ourselves to enter His presence with honor before we seek His instruction. *Isa 64:1; Ps 100:4; Phil 4:6; Heb 12:28*

Congregation: God’s ways and thoughts are higher than ours. He is our Creator, not our consultant. We are wise to adopt His agenda rather than rush into impulsive decisions. When we seek His will, He provides the blueprint to lead us into peace, purpose, and divine alignment. *Prov 16:9; 3:5-6; Jer 29:11*

ALL: Beyond our time, talent, treasure, and deeds, God desires our heart. He values inward repentance, obedience, and faithfulness far more than outward performance. He Word declares, “The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart—These, ... [He] will not despise.”

Pro 23:26; 1 Sam 16:7; Ps 51:17 AMEN.



Scripture Lesson: Judges 20:4-13 (NIV)

Leader: **4** So the Levite, the husband of the murdered woman, said, “I and my concubine came to Gibeah in Benjamin to spend the night. **5** During the night the men of Gibeah came after me and surrounded the house, intending to kill me. They raped my concubine, and she died.

Congregation: **6** I took my concubine, cut her into pieces and sent one piece to each region of Israel’s inheritance, because they committed this lewd and outrageous act in Israel. **7** Now, all you Israelites, speak up and tell me what you have decided to do.”

Leader: **8** All the men rose up together as one, saying, “None of us will go home. No, not one of us will return to his house. **9** But now this is what we’ll do to Gibeah: We’ll go up against it in the order decided by casting lots.

Congregation: **10** We’ll take ten men out of every hundred from all the tribes of Israel, and a hundred from a thousand, and a thousand from ten thousand, to get provisions for the army. Then, when the army arrives at Gibeah in Benjamin, it can give them what they deserve for this outrageous act done in Israel.”

ALL: **11** So all the Israelites got together and united as one against the city. **12** The tribes of Israel sent messengers throughout the tribe of Benjamin, saying, “What about this awful crime that was committed among you? **13** Now turn those wicked men of Gibeah over to us so that we may put them to death and purge the evil from Israel.” But the Benjamites would not listen to their fellow Israelites. AMEN.

PASTOR: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you,
That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

Congregation: John 6:35 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
