# Call To Worship

Leader: Today's recurring pattern of moral decline is rampant and can leave us feeling helpless and hopeless. The Good News, "... those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength" for He is "... an ever-present help in trouble."

John 16:33; Isaiah 40:31; 2 Cor 4:8-9; Psalm 46:1

Congregation: As we face the storms of life, may we invite God into our struggles -- not as a last resort, but as our first response through prayer. "Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you." Prayer is our lifeline.

Psalm 50:15; Philippians 1:6

ALL: While praising God during troubled seasons can be challenging, it can also be our breakthrough. Even when everything falls apart, let us choose "... a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair." AMEN. Acts 16:25-26; Psalm 34:1 Isaiah 61:3 Scripture Lesson: 2 Timothy 3:1-5, 10-14 (NIV)

Leader: 1 But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. 2 People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good,

Congregation: 4 treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God—5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people.

Leader: 10 You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, 11 persecutions, sufferings—what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them.

ALL: 12 In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, 13 while evildoers and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, AMEN.
