Call To Worship

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 63: 1-11 (KJV)

Leader: 1 O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; **2** To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary.

Congregation: 3 Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee. **4** Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.

Leader: 5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips: **6** When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches. **7** Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

Congregation: 8 My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me. **9** But those that seek my soul, to destroy it, shall go into the lower parts of the earth.

ALL: 10 They shall fall by the sword: they shall be a portion for foxes. **11** But the king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped. AMEN.
