**Sermon Title: Three Part Series - God. Family. Community.**

**Part One: "Put God First"**

## Call To Worship

**Leader:** God is not asking to be first among many priorities—He is asking for first place in our heart, soul, and mind. He does not desire to be an afterthought or an emergency contact. What we truly love, we intentionally prioritize with our time, attention, and devotion.

*Matt 22:37; Pro 4:23; Isa 29:13*

**Congregation:** God defines the day, not our schedule. Morning prayer is our recognition that He is our priority. Since in Him we live and move and have our being, it is only right that our day begins with Him.

*Acts 17:2; Psalm 5:3; Mark 1:35*

**ALL:** God is not only the first voice we should seek in the morning—He should be the last voice we speak to at night. Ending the day with prayer is an act of trust, releasing what we cannot control and resting in the One who never sleeps. When God is our first love, He becomes both the beginning and the end of our day. AMEN. *Psalm 4:8; Psalm 121:4*

## Scripture Lesson: Exodus 20:1-11 (NIV)

**Leader: 1** And God spoke all these words: **2** "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. **3** "You shall have no other gods before me.

**Congregation: 4** "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.

**Leader: 5** You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, **6** but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

**Congregation: 7** "You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

**8** "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. **9** Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

**Leader: 10** but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns.

**ALL: 11** For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy. AMEN.
