Sermon Title:

"JESUS CAN FIX IT, IF YOU 2026 IT."

Call To Worship

Leader: Children of God, we have the best wireless connection to Jesus — instant access, no delays. Prayer gives us direct and constant reach. Whatever 2025 tried to break, Jesus can fix it in 2026. "The Lord is near to all who call on Him." *Jer 33:3; Ps 145:18; Isa 65:24*

Congregation: Friends who let us talk are a blessing, but on this spiritual journey we need true prayer warriors — people who don't just listen but know how to intercede. They are spiritually equipped, intentional in their petitions, and able to pray us through what talking alone can't fix. Jesus said that when two agree in prayer, "it will be done." *Eccl 4:9-10; Gal 6:2; Matt 18:19*

ALL: We should never underestimate the power of persistent prayer. Along with our godly repentance and confession, we can experience healing, restoration, and breakthrough. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us and purify us" and the Lord declares, "I will restore your health and heal your wounds." AMEN. *1 John 1:9; Jer 30:17*



Scripture Lesson: James 5:13-16 (NIV)

Leader: 13 Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise.

Congregation: 14 Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord.

Leader: 15 And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.

ALL: 16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. AMEN.



NOTES:

PASTOR: 1 Cor. 11:23 (KJV)

For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

1 Cor 11:24 (NLT) 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”

Congregation: John 6:35 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

PASTOR 1 Cor. 11:25 (KJV)

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Congregation: Hebrews 9:22 (KJV)

And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding blood is no remission.
