SERMON TITLE: “WALKING BY GRACE.”

Call To Worship

Leader: It is by grace, we stand secure on this day not in our works, but in His mercy – “He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy” Come, let us worship with thankful hearts for grace freely given. *Titus 3:5*

Congregation: Step by step, walking by grace, we are carried by mercy beyond what we deserve – “He has shown [us] mercy and compassion.” Let us also extend grace to each other and worship the One who meets us with mercy.

Zech 7:9; Psa 103:8; Lam 3:22; Eph 2:4-5

ALL: Through walking by grace, we live in the blessing of salvation offered freely— “He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.” May we never overlook or neglect the grace that has brought us life. “How shall we escape if we ignore so great a great salvation?” Come, let us worship in joy and gratitude.
1 Peter 1:3; Hebrews 2:3 AMEN.



Scripture Reading/Lesson: Ephesians 2:1-8 NIV

Leader: 1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, **2** in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient.

Congregation: 3 All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our flesh and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath.

Leader: 4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, **5** made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

Congregation: 6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, **7** in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

ALL: 8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. AMEN.
