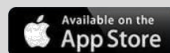

Sermon Title:

"THE PEACE OF THE PRINCE."

Call To Worship

Leader: God's peace is abundant and can be shared with all. Even a portion of His peace quiets our fears, heals divisions, anchors us, and calms life's storms; truly, "the peace of God... transcends all understanding" *John 14:27; Phil 4:7*

Congregation: Human promises of peace crumble with time, but Christ Himself is the lasting foundation of true peace. It does not shift with circumstance but steadies every heart that put trust in God and endures forever. *Heb 13:8; Isa 26:4*

ALL: Through His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus bridges the gap between humanity and God, offering eternal peace. "For to us a child is born... and He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." AMEN. *Rom 5:1; Isa 26:3, 9:6-7*



Scripture Lesson: John 14:22-29 (LBT)

Leader: 22 Judas (not Judas Iscariot, but the other disciple with that name) said to him, "Lord, why are you going to reveal yourself only to us and not to the world at large?"

Congregation: 23 Jesus replied, "All who love me will do what I say. My Father will love them, and we will come and make our home with each of them. **24** Anyone who doesn't love me will not obey me. And remember, my words are not my own. What I am telling you is from the Father who sent me. **25** I am telling you these things now while I am still with you.

Leader: 26 But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you.

Congregation: 27 "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.

ALL: 28 Remember what I told you: I am going away, but I will come back to you again. If you really loved me, you would be happy that I am going to the Father, who is greater than I am. **29** I have told you these things before they happen so that when they do happen, you will believe. AMEN.
