## ***Sermon Title: “I USED TO.”***

### ***Call To Worship***

**Leader:** Flashback ... when we used to chase what could never satisfy then fast-forward ... when Jesus, the Lover of our soul, found us, freed us, and filled us with grace. Today we can sing it and mean it, “Oh How I Love Jesus!” *Eccl 2:10–11; Ps 40:2; John 4:13–14*

**Congregation:** Our past captivity as servants of sin is over through the blood of Jesus Christ. We are now called to be free, but not to use our freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, “... so that we may serve the living God [humbly in love].” *Gal 5:13; Heb 9:14; 1 Pet 2:9*

**ALL:** Now being set free with a new alliance to love and serve the Lord, we must also transition our mindset and take our direction from God. “For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God’s sight.”  
**AMEN.** *1 Cor 3:19; Ps 32:8; John 14:26*



### ***Scripture Lesson: Romans 6:15-18 (NIV)***

**Leader:** **15** What then? Shall we sin because we are not under the law but under grace? By no means!

**Congregation:** **16** Don’t you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey—whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?

**ALL:** **17** But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you have come to obey from your heart the pattern of teaching that has now claimed your allegiance. **18** You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. **AMEN.**
