Sermon Title: "KEEP THE FIRE BURNING."

Call To Worship

Leader: From our walk with God, we know that loving the Lord with all our heart is intentional and intense. Each day we rise in His mercy, seeking His will, His provision, and His deliverance. Half-hearted love has no place in this relationship.

Congregation: As we sing, "I'm Glad To Be in His Service," let this be more than a melody — let it be our declaration. The same fire that burned in Jeremiah — that holy fire that refuses lukewarm effort and compels us to serve with passion, devotion, and unwavering faith. Jer 20:9

ALL: Our prayer and praise keep us connected to God, for He inhabits the praises of His people — where praise is, His presence and His fire dwell. A prayerless and praiseless life is a powerless life; but a life filled with prayer and praise is a life filled with fire. AMEN. Psalm 22:3; James 5:16



Scripture Lesson/Reading: Leviticus 6:8-13 (NIV)

Leader: 8 The Lord said to Moses: **9** "Give Aaron and his sons this command: 'These are the regulations for the burnt offering: The burnt offering is to remain on the altar hearth throughout the night, till morning, and the fire must be kept burning on the altar.'

Congregation: 10 The priest shall then put on his linen clothes, with linen undergarments next to his body, and shall remove the ashes of the burnt offering that the fire has consumed on the altar and place them beside the altar.

Leader: 11 Then he is to take off these clothes and put on others and carry the ashes outside the camp to a place that is ceremonially clean.

Congregation: 12 The fire on the altar must be kept burning; it must not go out. Every morning the priest is to add firewood and arrange the burnt offering on the fire and burn the fat of the fellowship offerings on it.

ALL: 13 The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out. AMEN.
