Title – **The Unveiling of Jesus: Savior, Teacher, or God Incarnate?**

Text – Luke 2:39-52

Explore the Passage

Start by reading over this week's passage.

The sermon mentions a surprising statistic where 43% of Evangelicals in America consider Jesus to be a great teacher but not God. How do you think misunderstandings about Jesus' identity impact Christian faith and practice today? What steps can churches take to address and clarify such misconceptions?

Jesus, as both fully divine and fully human, willingly chose to live within the limitations of humanity during His earthly ministry. How does this doctrine of the Incarnation deepen your understanding of Jesus' life and mission? What significance does it hold for your faith journey?

Do you tend to think of and focus more on Jesus's humanity or deity? What's the danger of neglecting one?

Jesus' statement about being in His Father's house signifies His divine identity and purpose. How does your relationship with God shape your understanding of personal purpose and calling? How can we align our lives more closely with God's will, following Jesus' example of submission and obedience?

Share one truth you have learned from this passage that you could pass on to someone else. It could be helping to disciple a friend, spouse, child, or even a seeking neighbor.
