Home Group Discussion Guide

Title – Let It Be: Surrendering to God's Impossible Plans Text – Luke 1:26-54

Explore the Passage

Start by reading over this week's passage.

On Sunday, Pastor said that the one word that describes the circumstances and setting of Gabriel's announcement to Mary was insignificant. Mary wasn't rich or famous and Nazareth wasn't a big, influential place. What does this teach us about the kind of kingdom that the kingdom of God is? What does it teach us about Jesus?

Compare and contrast Mary's doubting in verse 34 with Zechariah's doubt when the angel appeared to him. What kind of doubt is good or acceptable to God? What kind of doubt isn't?

"The moment you admit the existence of God, you must deny the impossible."

What have you seen God do in your life that seemed impossible to you?

Read over Mary's song, verse's 46-54. What sticks out to you from this song? What does it teach us about God?

Share one truth you have learned from this passage that you could pass on to someone else. It could be helping to disciple a friend, spouse, child, or even a seeking neighbor.
