- 1. Just like the people of Israel were called to prepare for the Lord, believers must also prepare their hearts for God by removing any obstacles between them and God.
- 2. The first reason for preparing your heart is that God reveals His glory to us.
- 3. The second reason for preparing your heart is that God reveals to us that our lives are short like grass that eventually dies.
- 4. The third reason for preparing your heart is that God shows that His truth in the Bible is eternal—even though we die, God's Word is eternal and never ends. This gives us hope!
