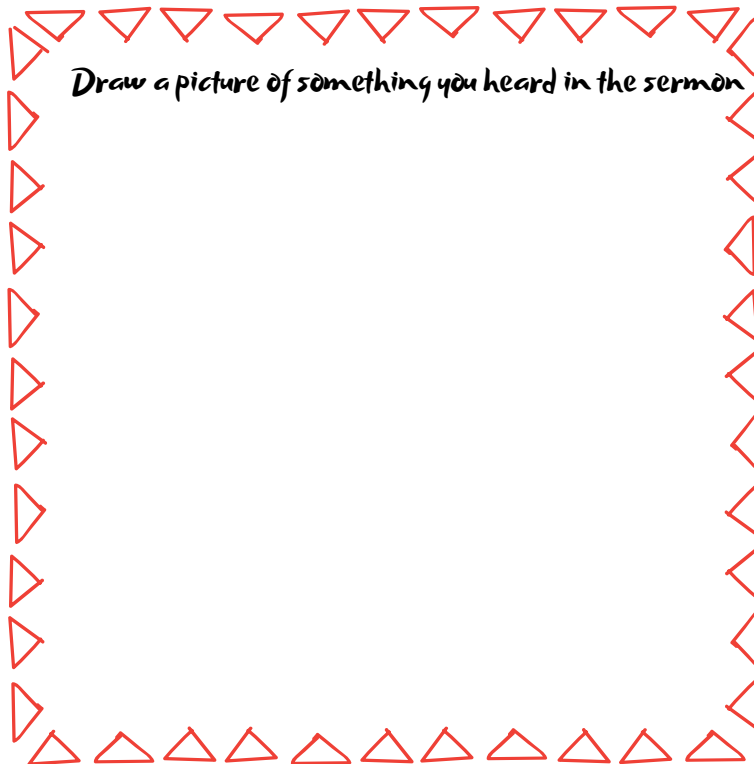

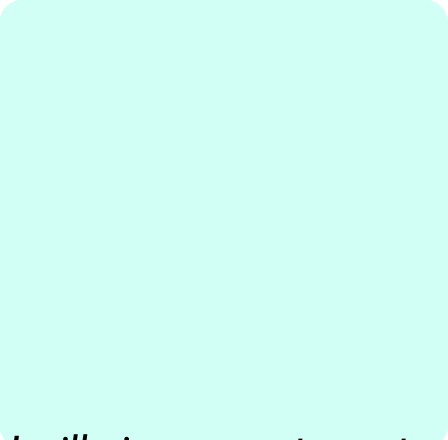

I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophecy for 1260 days.



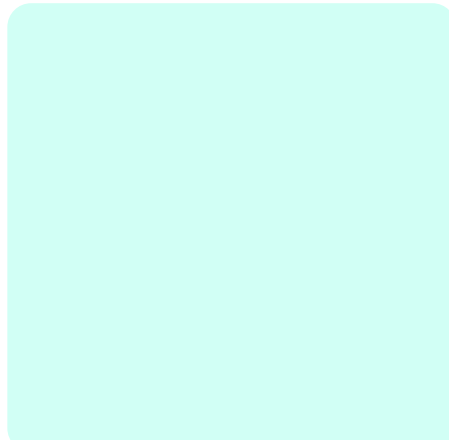
They are clothed in sackcloth.



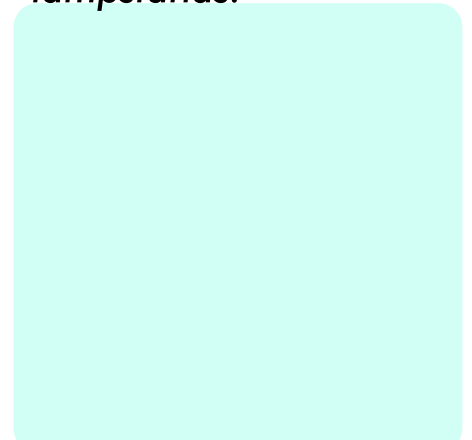
These are the two olive trees, and the two lampstands.
