

***RESURRECTION INAUGURATED: RUN AFTER KING JESUS AND MAKE THE PHARISEES GAG
JOHN 12:9-19; LUKE 19:41-44***

II. Jesus Comes to Jerusalem as Its Promised King and Christ (Jn. 12:12-18)

III. Jesus Weeps Over Jerusalem's Disbelief and Coming Destruction (Jn.12:19; Luke 19:41-44)

Discussion Questions:

- 1) Have you ever gone to an unforgettable parade? What made it great? How was it similar and different from the parade that was thrown for Jesus as he entered Jerusalem?
- 2) Can you think of a testimony told by a Christian that impacted you? Whose was it and why was it impactful?
- 3) Do you have a testimony that you can share with your group? Maybe how you came to trust in Jesus, or how He helped you this week, or how He helped you in a big way in the past?
- 4) How did the Pharisees' misuse and misunderstanding of Scripture lead their minds and hearts away from God's heart?

One Thing:

This week, think about how and why Jesus entered Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. What sticks out to you most about His entrance? His heart for the lost? His humility? His message of salvation? Whatever amazes you about Jesus, use that as a catalyst this week to encourage believers and unbelievers alike with the message of Jesus' humble coming, death, and awesome resurrection from the dead!
