Daily Confession

I declare that my mind belongs to God. I will not accept every thought that comes to me. I bring my thoughts into agreement with the Word of God.

God loves me, and His love is the foundation of my faith. Because I know He loves me, I refuse thoughts of fear, hopelessness, rejection, defeat, and anxiety.

I will not allow circumstances to define what I believe about God or about my future. God's Word is my guardrail, and His truth has the final say.

I am being transformed by the renewing of my mind. I choose to think on what is true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of a good report.

I meditate on God's Word until His truth becomes stronger in me than what I see, hear, or feel.

I guard my heart and my words. Life is in my tongue, so I speak faith, hope, healing, victory, and the promises of God over my life.

When a thought comes, I discern it. I ask: Does this agree with God's Word? Does this agree with His love for me? If it does not, I reject it and replace it with truth.

I cast down imaginations and every thought that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. I take my thoughts captive and bring them into obedience to Christ.

I am not hopeless. I am not forgotten. I am not defeated. God is with me. God loves me. His Word is alive and working in me.

My faith works by love. My mind is renewed by truth. My heart is filled with the Word of God, and what comes out of me will produce life.
