

## Vision Beyond Barriers: Dream Connections

### Study Guide

#### Summary & Objective

This lesson explores biblical revelation (apokaluptō) as God's unveiling of Jesus that produces faith, obedience, healing, and clear direction. Objective: Help participants understand that revelation is given to transform lives through obedient faith.

#### 1. Revelation Belongs to Us

Scripture: Deut. 29:29; Amos 3:7

God reveals truth so His people can obey and participate in His purposes.

- Biblical Exposition: How does Deut. 29:29 connect revelation with obedience?
- Application: Where is God calling you to obey what He has already revealed?

#### 2. Revelation Unveils Jesus

Scripture: Acts 10:9-20

Peter's vision shows revelation often comes through prayer and unfolds progressively.

- Biblical Exposition: What did Peter learn through the vision?
- Application: How can you cultivate a lifestyle that welcomes God's revelation?

#### 3. Revelation Produces Healing Faith

Scripture: Mark 5:25-34; Matt.9:20-22; Acts3:1-8

When Jesus is revealed, faith responds and God's healing power is experienced.

- Biblical Exposition: What role did faith play in these healings?
- Application: How can you respond to Jesus with greater confidence this week?

#### 4. Four-Step Cooperation

Scripture: Deut.29:29

Interpretation, Intelligence, Instructions, Expectation.

- Biblical Exposition: Why must revelation lead to action?
- Application: Which step do you most need to strengthen?

## **Scripture References**

### **Deuteronomy 29:29**

The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

### **Amos 3:7**

Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

### **Acts 10:9-20**

Peter went up to pray, received a vision, and the Holy Spirit instructed him to go with the men God had sent.

### **Mark 5:25-34**

The woman with the issue of blood touched Jesus in faith and was healed.

### **Matthew 9:20-22**

Jesus declared, 'Your faith has made you well.'

### **Acts 3:1-8**

Peter healed the lame man in the name of Jesus Christ, and he walked.
