

Vision Beyond Barriers: Don't Be the Barrier

Point 1 – Find the Word

Biblical Exposition: According to Jeremiah 29:11 and Deuteronomy 29:29, what is the difference between God's revealed will and His hidden purposes, and what responsibility do believers have toward what God has revealed?

Application: What is one truth or promise from God's Word that you need to intentionally seek, study, or trust more fully this week?

Point 2 – Speak the Word

Biblical Exposition: How does Jeremiah 29:11 reveal God's heart toward His people, and why is agreeing with God's Word through our confession an expression of faith?

Application: What negative thought, fear, or circumstance do you need to replace by consistently speaking God's promises over your life this week?

Point 3 – Possess the Word

Biblical Exposition: What does Jeremiah 29:11 teach about God's intentions for His people, and what does it mean to receive His promises by faith rather than merely knowing them?

Application: What promise of God have you believed intellectually but not yet acted upon, and what step of faith can you take this week to begin possessing it?

Point 4 – Birth the Word

Biblical Exposition: According to Joel 2:28, how does the outpouring of the Holy Spirit enable God's people to receive vision, dream His dreams, and bring His purposes to fulfillment?

Application: What vision, calling, or assignment has God placed in your heart, and what practical step will you take this week to begin bringing it to life through the Spirit's guidance?
