## Relational Favor: Who You Kin To?

#### 1. Lesson Summary

This lesson combines two powerful truths: the necessity of faith and the blessing of relational favor. We explore how consistency in faith and knowing who you are connected to determines your spiritual outcomes. Jesus is our standard of faith, and relational favor positions us to reap blessings through divine connections. The objective is to stir participants to both release faith with boldness and recognize the divine favor that flows through relationships.

### 2. Key Scriptures

- Mark 11:22-24
- Ruth 2:2-11
- Galatians 3:29

#### 3. Lesson Points & Discussion Questions

#### **Point 1: Consistency in Faith**

Scripture: Mark 11:22-24

Jesus instructs us to believe that we receive when we pray. This requires consistency in confession, belief, and corresponding action. Faith must be released with boldness and sustained by grace.

**Discussion Questions:** 

- 1. What does consistent faith look like in your daily walk?
- 2. How does grace empower your faith?

#### Point 2: Jesus is the Standard

Jesus operated in perfect grace and faith. He is our model for how to walk in confidence and power. Faith must match the grace given for each assignment.

**Discussion Questions:** 

- 1. How can you align your faith with the grace on your life?
- 2. What areas of life is Jesus calling you to imitate His standard?

#### **Point 3: Relational Favor**

Scriptures: Ruth 2:2–11, Galatians 3:29

Ruth found favor because of her connection to Naomi. Relational favor allows you to reap where you did not sow. In Christ, we are heirs—divinely connected. Favor will find you when you walk in obedience.

### **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. How have your divine connections brought favor into your life?
- 2. What does it mean to 'share the favor' God has given you?

Final Insight: Favor will come and find you—but you must be in position, actively obeying, and walking in the grace assigned to you.
