EVERYDAY JESUS IS A GREAT WAY TO DEEPEN YOUR BIBLE READING, PRAYER LIFE & PERSONAL TIME WITH CHRIST.

Monday: Read Romans 1:18
God has a wrath against sin. Why is sin so bad?

Tuesday: Read Romans 1:19-20
In what ways can we see God? Even though we cannot see the wind, we know it's there.

Wednesday: Read Romans 1:18-32
(Day of Fasting) Is there something you've been praying for that you want the Lord to do?

Thursday: Read Romans 1:21-23
An idol is any person, place, thing, or thought that you look to in order to get your needs met apart from God.

Friday: Read Romans 1:28-32
Our world has given into sin and the approval of sin. Why has God allowed this?

Saturday: Read Romans 1:18-32
Begin to move towards your purpose in God through prayer and scripture reading.
