Everyday Jesus

Monday: Read 1 Kings 22:29-34
Ahab had been warned that the battle would end in disaster but he fought anyway.

Tuesday: Read 1 Kings 22:35-40
Ahab died as a result of his disobedience. What could he have done differently?

Wednesday: Read 1 Kings 22:29-53
(Day of Fasting) Is there something you've been praying for that you want the Lord to do?

Thursday: Read 1 Kings 22:41-53
Ahab's oldest son did what was evil in the Lord's sight. How can we learn from this?

Friday: Read 1 Kings 22:41-53
The Lord was committed to fulfilling his kingdom purposes despite the sins of His people.

Saturday: Read 1 Kings 22:29-53
Begin to move towards your purpose in God through prayer and scripture reading.
