## Faithful Parents - Generational Righteousness

*Today's Parenting Proverb:* Proverbs 20:6-7 | Many a man proclaims his own steadfast love, but a faithful man who can find? The righteous who walks in his integrity — blessed are his children after him!

[Big Idea] Your children are watching. What are they seeing? We need to be intentional about following Christ in the way we live and communicate His story clearly to them.

### I. Deut. 6:4-9 Faithfulness as a way we live life

[Discussion] In what ways are our children witnessing us loving the Lord consistent with Deut. 6:4-9?

[Discussion] How are we fostering the notion within our family that conversations between parent and child are normal? How are we ensuring that those conversations are rooted in the Gospel?

## III. Deut. 7:6-11 God's faithfulness to bless faith (taking the long view)

[Discussion] Have we been witness to God's generational blessing in our lives? Are we willing to rest in God for that long journey?

[Extension Activity]: Get a copy of the new family devotional book (Old Story New) to study scripture alongside our kids Sunday School. Begin using it this week.
