

# Judging Others Motives is a Path to Depression

Jer 17:5,9-10:-"Thus says the Lord, Cursed is the man who trusts in mankind and makes flesh his strength...The heart is more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick; Who can understand it? I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give to each man according to his way, According to the results of his deeds."

Matt 7:1-2-"Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your measure, it will be measured to you."

This scripture tells us that if we judge other people, other people are going to judge us, not God judging us. Parallel scripture is Luke 6:38-"Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom."

#### Signs of Pride (VS) Humility

Proud people have a critical, fault-finding spirit. They look at everyone else's faults with a microscope and their own with a telescope. Humble people are compassionate-they have the kind of love that overlooks a multitude of sins; they can forgive much because they know how much they have been forgiven. Matt 7:3-"Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye?"
