A Sermon Reflection Insert for the 12th Sunday after Pentecost

Scripture: Matthew 15:21-28, with Matthew 15:10-20

Great faith calls us beyond narrow hearts and toward God's mercy.

Take this with you:

Use these prompts for prayer, family conversation, small-group discussion, or personal reflection during the week.

1 Listen from the margins.

2 Practice great faith. What does the Canaanite woman teach us about praying, acting, and trusting Jesus when the need cannot wait?

3 Ask for changed hearts and minds. What assumptions, habits, or boundaries might Jesus be calling us to surrender?

4 Go out in love. What one faithful action can I take this week to bring healing, justice, or hope?

Lord Jesus, change our hearts where they have grown hard, change our minds where they have grown narrow, and send us out with great faith to love, serve, and help heal the world. Amen.

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
