

The Fruitful Grain of Wheat

Read: John 12:20-26

- Jesus is in Jerusalem.
- Greeks are asking to see Jesus at the Passover celebration.
- John wants to show us that Jesus really is the King, not just of Israel, but of the "whole world."
- V23-26, The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. In other words, I am on my way to glory.
- Then, in typical Jesus fashion, He teaches by making this statement...

Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.

- Jesus is explaining, His pathway to glory is through death.
- V25-26.

Jesus is speaking of the fundamental choice between the World and God.
