Read: Mark 5:35-43.

- Mark 5:23 Jairus begs Jesus passionately to come heal his daughter, as Jesus is on his way, there is a woman that comes up from behind him and touches his garments, and she is healed. During that miracle, and time spent finding out who touched his garment, the daughter of the ruler of the synagogue dies.
- V35, His friends from the synagogue come to him and say, “your daughter is dead.”
- V36, Jesus said to the ruler, "Do not be afraid only believe.”
- I can almost hear Jesus say ,“DON'T BURY IT YET.”
- Many times there's something remaining there. There's something left for Jesus to work with.

- There was one factor that changed it. It wasn't her breath of life, no, that was gone. It wasn't a heartbeat, no, that was gone. It was faith.

- V36... "Don't be afraid." He said, " only believe."

- It just takes a little faith. Don't Bury It Yet...

- Jesus knew the enemy of Faith is fear...

- V36, Don't be afraid, only believe...

- Fear tries to bury our faith.

- Numbers 13, Moses and the children of God looking for the land God promised. The Lord told Moses to send 12 spies into the area.

- Numbers 13:27-28 & Numbers 13:32-33.

- Fear says “you’re a grasshopper” but faith says “you’re a giant killer.”

- God is in us: Romans 8:9, Galatians 2:20.

- God is with us: Matthew 1:23.

- God is for us: Romans 8:31.
