### **Show Notes:**

1. Envision is a system of raising up new workers. Through its website [www.envisioncanada.org](http://www.envisioncanada.org) we find ways to:
  - a. Go as a group to an envision site
  - b. Do a several month internship
  - c. Do a two-year apprenticeship
  - d. Go as a career worker by joining an existing team.
2. One page on the website is 'GAP' which is the idea of providing a gap year for youth wanting a change or break after completing a study period. There is both a Justice Semester and a Global Semester [www.envisioncanada.org/global-semester](http://www.envisioncanada.org/global-semester)
3. The Global Semester is a cohort of 4-8 people coming together for an 8-week internship in a variety of countries. The first is June/July 2019 in Senegal with a second October/November in the Middle East. In 2020 there will be one in Vancouver as well as others in Asia. We could also say that the Global Semester is like a roadmap for discernment.
4. There are three desired outcomes for the Global Semester:
  - a. To see and experience what international workers are experiencing
  - b. To hear God stories and learn about types of ministries, about options and opportunities.
  - c. To communicate and engage with your local church in journeying into mission together.
