Step 1:

GET REAL

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: **GET FED**

Discuss John Chapter 13

What stood out to you as you read this chapter?

- **Before telling of Jesus washing the Apostles feet, what things does verses 1-3 mention that Jesus knew?**
- **What did “knowing” these things have to do with Jesus washing the Apostles feet and what He would teach them afterward?**
- **Why did Peter not think Jesus should wash his (or really anyone’s) feet?**
- **Why reasons do followers today have for not serving as Christ did?**
- **Jesus did not just wash the Apostles feet (including Judas) just to teach them a lesson. WHAT OTHER GREATER REASON DID HE WASH THEIR FEET?**
- **What was new about the commandment that Jesus gave them in verse 34? How and why does loving each other help Jesus’ followers stand out? (V35)**

Step 3:

GET ACTIVE

“As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God’s grace.” 1 Peter 4:10

Pray specifically that God will help you see the gifts and opportunities He has given you to serve others.

Search for ways to serve others this week and if possible by using the gift(s) God has blessed you with.
