Step 1:

GET REAL

The Gospel according to

What are you thankful for from the past week?

What struggles did you face?

What can you share from your personal Bible reading?

- (other than the designated chapter of John)

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: **GET FED**

Discuss John Chapter 4

What stood out to you as you read this chapter?

Why did Jesus himself “not baptize, but only His disciple?” (V2)

What does verse 4 mean that Jesus “had to pass through Samaria?”

Why did the “Jews have no dealing with the Samaritans?” (V9)

What can we learn from how Jesus treated the Samaritan?

How is it that those who drink “living water” will never thirst again?

How can we use own stories to point people to Jesus? (v39-40)

The official “believed the word Jesus spoke to him.” What promises do we need to believe so that Christ can do great things in our lives?

Step 3:

GET ACTIVE

Seek to see people as Christ sees them. In your individual interactions with people this week look past the surface and ask, “How would Christ treat this person?” “What do they need?” “What would Jesus say?”

Seek to point people to Jesus. As the Samaritan woman did, look for ways to point people to Jesus through your story.
