Step 2: GET FED

Discuss 1 Samuel 13:15-14:52

- ** What stood out to you as you read this section?**
- 1 Samuel 14:6 says, “Nothing can hinder the Lord from saving by many or by few.” When have you witnessed this in your life? Why do we often forget this?**
- What can we learn from Jonathan and his armor bearer’s willingness to attack the Philistines?**
- What specific ways can we walk by faith more in our daily life?**
- How did the Israelites respond to the boldness of Jonathan? What can we learn from this?**
- How was Saul’s reaction to Jonathan’s disobedience in this section different to how he reacted to his own sin in last week’s reading? Why? Do we do this?**
- 1 Samuel 14:52 says that Saul attached himself to the strong, valiant men he met. What person of strong faith has impacted your life?**
- Saul’s rule was filled with war, what “wars” will we continually face in our lives?**
