

Step 1: GETREAL

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: GET FED

Discuss 1 Samuel 17

What stood out to you as you read this chapter?

- Why do you think the story of David and Goliath is so well known and liked?"
- How old do you think David was when He fought Goliath? (Numbers 1:3)
- What are the current giants you are facing? What giants do you believe God's people today are facing?
- Fear kept the army of Israel from fighting Goliath. What is fear keeping the Lord's army today from doing?
- How did God prepare David long before he fought Goliath? How does he prepare us?
- At first Saul told David could not beat Goliath. How can you handle a lack of faith in others when it is directed toward you?
- David's victory demonstrated God's sovereign power. How can we glorify God when He brings victory in our lives?
- David's faith gave courage to the army of Israel. What effect does our faith in action or fear have on those around us?

Step 3: GET ACTIVE
