Step 1:

GET REAL

- (other than the designated chapter of John)

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: **GET FED**

Discuss John Chapter 14

What stood out to you as you read this chapter?

- In verse one Jesus says, “Do not let your hearts be troubled.” What specifically has your heart been troubled about recently?
- What promises and reasons does Jesus give in this chapter to help our hearts to not be troubled? (i.e. Verses 2-4, 13-14, 16-17, 23-27)
- What did Jesus mean by “I am in the Father and the Father is in me?” (V10)
- How would “whoever believes in” (Jesus) “do greater works” than Jesus had been doing? How have you been doing the works of Christ?
- What main reason does Jesus give for saying He would do whatever we ask for in His name? (Vv13-14)
- By what names does Jesus call the Holy Spirit in this chapter, and how is He those things to believers?

Step 3:

GET ACTIVE

“Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.” John 14:27

Jesus saw that his disciples were troubled and scared and He comforted them.

If you know of someone or see, in your interactions, that someone is troubled, encouraged them with God’s promises and pray with them.
