

Step 1: GETREAL

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: GET FED

Discuss 1 Samuel 2:12-3:21

What stood out to you as you read this section?

- Eli's sons wanted their portion of the meat before it was sacrificed to God. How do we
 place ourselves above the will of the Lord?
- The Lord blessed Hannah even after answering her original request. How has God responded to your prayers with blessings that were greater than what you asked for?
- God told Eli that he had honored his sons over Him. (2:29) Who is it that we might be in danger of honoring over the Lord?
- What can we learn from how Eli handled the sin of his sons?
- The Lord spoke directly to Samuel; How does God speak to us today?
- Eli told Samuel to respond, "Speak Lord for your servant hears." How can we apply this advice today? (3:9)
- What can we learn from Eli's response to God's message to Samuel?
- What does it mean to "let the Lord do what seems good to Him?" (3:18)

Step 3: GET ACTIVE

"Speak Lord for your servant hears"

Speak to God from your heart and ask Him to reveal to you how He can use you for His will; then open your ears and eyes for His answer.
