As of last Sunday, numerous donations had already been received. You answered the call.

The new deacons created a new involvement interest survey. You are answering the call to serve in so many ways.

I Peter 4:8-11

8 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. 9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. 10
