Step 1:

GET REAL

What are you thankful for from the past week?

What struggles did you face?

What can you share from your personal Bible reading?

- (other than the designated chapter of John)

Where did you see God in your daily life?

Step 2: GET FED

What does Jesus attending a wedding say to you about him?

What do you think would happen, if you addressed your mother, as “Woman”?

What did Jesus mean in saying that his “hour had not yet come?” His hour for what?

Does it bother you that Jesus made actual “wine”? Why or why not?

What does the quality of the wine which Jesus made say about him?

What was John’s purpose in recording the signs (miracles) which Jesus did? (20:30-31)

Why was Jesus so distressed by the buyers and sellers in the Temple?

What sign did Jesus offer as proof of his authority to clear out the Temple?

Given that we, too, are God’s Temple (1 Cor. 3:16-17), do you think that we need to clear anything out? If so, what?

Does it trouble you to see the God of love (1 John 4:8), so upset about what was happening in the Temple? If so, why?

Why do you think it was necessary for Jesus to clear the Temple TWICE? (Here at the beginning of his ministry; also at the end, Matt. 21, Mark 11, Luke 19)

Step 3:

GET ACTIVE

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Mary told the servants to “Do whatever he tells you” (v. 5).

Pick out one thing which Jesus has told you to do.

Do it this week.

Read John chapter 3, discuss it with your family, and be ready to share your thoughts next week.
