- How do we guard our hearts so that God remains king of our life?**

- What insight into our relationship with God can be seen by the things we ask God for?**
- What does it mean to be yoked together with believers?**
- What impact can being yoked together with unbelievers have on us?**
- How do we fight the individualistic nature of our society to have this type of strong bond with others in Christ?**
