Why was Jesus glad that he was not with Lazarus when he passed away (v. 14-15)? What ironic foreshadowing to you see in Thomas' comment (v. 16)? [Gal. 2:20; Col. 3:5] How can we best comfort those who have lost a loved one (v. 19)? On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate Martha's faith in Jesus (v. 21-27, 39)? On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate Mary's faith (v. 32-33)? What does it mean that Jesus "is the resurrection and the life" (v. 25)? How does Jesus being "deeply moved" (v. 33, 38) and "weeping" (v. 35) impact you? "If you believe, you will see the glory of God" (v. 40). Will you see his glory? What applications for public prayer do you see in v. 41-42? True or False: "the dead man" came out (v. 44 NIV, RSV, Darby, et al.)? Relate v. 45 to 20:30-31. Do you believe that Jesus is the Christ, God's Son? If so, Why? What's wrong with the Sanhedrin's position in v. 47-48? What parallels come to mind? What do you find unusual about Caiaphas' prophecy (v. 49-52)?
