# Step 1: GETREAL

- Why do you think Jesus responded to the people by weeping?
- What is different about Jesus' emotion vs the emotion of the people?
- Describe Jesus' message in vs 23-26 in your own words.
- Share how the power of Jesus brings comfort and hope to you.

### Mark 5:35-43, Luke 7:11-17, John 11:38-44

- What do these stories have in common?
- What do these miracles tell us about the power of Jesus?

## Step 2: GET FED

### Romans 3:23-26, 6:1-10, 1 Corinthians 15:56-57

According to these verses, what consequences came with sin?

How are these consequences conquered?

What changes in a person's life when they die with Christ? What dies? What hope does dying with Christ bring to your life?

#### Romans 6:11-14

What does the resurrected life with Christ look like?

What does it mean to be an instrument of righteousness?

How does this apply to your everyday life?

What is the connection between Jesus' statement in John 11:25-26

and Paul's Statement in Romans 6?

How does this impact your perspective on life and death?

# Step 2: GETFED / dig deeper

### John 6:35, 8:12, 10:10-11, 11:25, 14:6, 15:6

- Besides being part of the "I Am Statements," what is a common word or theme found throughout these statements?
- Why do you think that bringing life is such an important part of Jesus' ministry?
- What hope does life in Jesus bring to you?
- How would you describe this hope to someone who does not understand life with Jesus?
- Describe the reasoning of your belief in Jesus as the Great I Am?
- How are you experiencing the death and resurrection of Jesus?

# Step 3: GET ACTIVE

Review and Study: Take time this week to go back and study each of the seven I Am statements. Choose one or two to reflect on what they mean to your life. Discover how Jesus being that "I Am" can bring you comfort and encourage you to take a new step in your spiritual journey.
