What stood out to you as you read this chapter?

- What characteristics do you believe a true friend must have?
- How has God used a true friend or friends in your life to help and guide you?
- **How has the enemy used bad friends to hurt your life and faith?**
- What do you think of David and Jonathan's covenant? (1 Samuel 20:42)
- **What parallels do you see in their covenant relationship and ours?**
- What do we get from our spiritual relationship that we cannot get anywhere else?
- **What do we learn from Saul's actions about what jealousy can grow into?**
- What does Jonathan teach us about seeking to be peacemakers?
- **How has Christ shown Himself to be your greatest friend?**

Step 3: GET ACTIVE

Are my friendships bringing me closer to Christ or pulling me away?
