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Faith is characterized more by normal OBEDIENCE than extraordinary OBEDIENCE.

John 18:28-32

Villains RARELY think they are villains.

SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS is the inability or unwillingness to SEE the TRUTH about GOD or REALITY.

SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS does NOT always look like REBELLION. Sometimes it looks like DEVOTION.

Embracing Spiritual Blindness:
Choosing where and when to be faithful.

Measuring faithfulness based on externals.

Avoiding Spiritual Blindness:

Keep your HEART OPEN to God's WORD.

Treat ALL obedience the SAME.

TEST your HEART.
