John 15:4 - 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.

John 15:6-11 - 6 If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

ABIDING in JESUS transforms what we WANT, how we LIVE, and how we are LOVED.

What would JESUS want you to ASK for?

What you do in LIFE does not make YOU who you ARE.

John 15:9-11 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

There is nothing MORE you can DO that would make JESUS love you MORE.

*Produces Fruit of the spirit.*

*It shapes what we ask for,*

What are some things Jesus wants you to ask for?

Why do we confuse who we are with what we do?

On what basis does Jesus love us? Why does he love us? What should that motivate in us?

*Produces peace that passeth understanding*
