1. PROVE YOUR FAITH.

2. PREPARE YOU FOR PURPOSE.

<u>Consider it pure joy</u>, my brothers and sisters, <u>whenever you face trials of many kinds</u>, because you know that the <u>testing of your faith produces perseverance</u>. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may <u>be mature and complete</u>, <u>not lacking anything</u>. (James 1:2-4 NIV)
