

Fast Facts about Spiritual Growth

THE LAWS OF GROWTH

1. Spiritual growth is **INTENTIONAL**.

"I've <u>committed</u> myself and I'll never turn back from living by your righteous order." (Psalm 119:106, The Message)



TRUTH: I AM AS MATURE AS I CHOOSE TO BE.

2. Spiritual growth is **SEQUENTIAL**.

"Next, learn to put aside your own desires...letting God have his way with you. This will make possible the <u>next step</u>...The more you go on in this way, the more you will grow strong spiritually and become fruitful and useful to our Lord Jesus Christ." (2 Peter 1:6–8, The Living Bible)



TRUTH: EVERYONE HAS A NEXT STEP.

3. Spiritual growth is **PRACTICAL**.

"Work hard so God can say to you, "Well done." Be a good workman, one who does not need to be ashamed when God examines your work. <u>Know what his Word says and</u> <u>means</u>." (2 Timothy 2:15, The Living Bible)

4. Spiritual growth is **<u>RELATIONAL</u>**.

"And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, <u>not</u> <u>giving up meeting together</u>, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:24–25, NIV)

5. Spiritual growth is **SEASONAL**.

6. Spiritual Growth is **PERSONAL**.

7. Spiritual growth is **DEVELOPMENTAL**.

- YOUNG stage = <u>EMPLOYING</u> grace.
- **PARENT** stage = **DEPLOYING** grace.
