How God Brings Healing

"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways..." (2 Chronicles 7:14, NIV)

1. ALIGN MYSELF SPIRITUALLY.

"If my people, who are called by my name..."

"Through Christ, God has given us the privilege and authority...to tell [people] everywhere what God has done for them, so that they will believe and obey him, bringing glory to his name." (Romans 1:5, NLT)

"The time has come for the judgment to begin, and it will begin with God's family." (1 Peter 4:17a, GW)

"Examine yourselves to see if your faith is genuine. Test yourselves. Surely you know that Jesus Christ is among you; if not, you have failed the test of genuine faith." (2 Corinthians 13:5, NLT)

2. CONFESS MY ATTITUDE HONESTLY.

"...will humble themselves..."

"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." (James 4:6b, NLT)

"People who conceal their sins will not prosper, but if they confess and turn from them, they will receive mercy." (Proverbs 28:13, NLT)

"You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had." (Philippians 2:5, NLT)

"Finally, all of you should be of one mind. <u>Sympathize</u> with each other. <u>Love</u> each other as brothers and sisters. Be <u>tenderhearted</u>, and keep a <u>humble</u> attitude." (1 Peter 3:8, NLT)

3. PRAY <u>EARNESTLY</u>.

"...and pray..."

"Be <u>earnest</u> and unwearied and steadfast in your prayer [life], being [both] alert and <u>intent</u> in [your praying] with <u>thanksgiving</u>." (Colossians 4:2, AMP)

"I urge you, first of all, to pray for <u>all people</u>. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. Pray this way for [rulers] and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. This is good and <u>pleases God our Savior</u>," (1 Timothy 2:1–3, NLT)

"Pray in the Spirit at all times with all kinds of prayers, asking for everything you need. To do this you must always be ready and never <u>give up</u>. <u>Always pray</u> for all God's people." (Ephesians 6:18, NCV)

4. SEEK GOD PREEMINENTLY.

"...and **seek** my face..."

"[God] rewards those who earnestly seek him." (Hebrews 11:6, NIV)

"Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need." (Matthew 6:33, NLT)

5. LIVE <u>CIRCUMSPECTLY</u>.
