THE MODERN MISSIONS MOVEMENT:

- 1792-1910: PIONEERS: Continental-Coastlands
- 1865-Present: PROFESSIONALS: Mission Agencies: Continental-Inlands->UUPGs

WHAT THEY DID RIGHT: Recaptured the Great Commission!

CHALLENGES:

- 1. Requires massive funding for only a "few" professionals.
- 2. Creates co-dependency in the targeted people group.
- 3. Unintentionally exported western Christianity.
- 4. It ignores the fact that UUPGs are best reached by their nearest neighbors.
- 5. Shifted the Great Commission away from the local church.

RISE OF THE SHORT-TERM MISSIONS MOVEMENT

- 1960-Present: Ministry Centered Missions
 - Volunteers on short-term trips (typically 2 weeks)
 - "Safe" destinations
 - Project centered (one and done)
 - o Over 1,000 Agencies sending over 2 million participants annually

WHAT THEY DID RIGHT: Returned the task to ordinary people!

CHALLENGES:

- 1. Multiplies the problems of co-dependency.
- 2. Encourages scams and begging.
- 3. Floods 3rd world countries with "sympathy" money.
- 4. Hurts the local church.
