## STEPS IN GOD'S HEALING PROCESS

# **REVEAL** MY HURTS

"I kept very quiet. I didn't even say anything good, but I became even more upset. I became very angry inside, and as I thought about it, my anger burned." (Psalm 39:2–3, NCV)

"When I kept things to myself, I felt weak deep inside me. I moaned all day long." (Psalm 32:3, NCV)

# **RELEASE** THOSE WHO'VE HURT ME

"Never pay back evil for evil... never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it." (Romans 12:17, 19, The Living Bible)
