CHRISTMAS ISN'T COMPLICATED

At that time the Roman emperor, Augustus, decreed that a census should be taken throughout the Roman Empire.² (This was the first census taken when Quirinius was governor of Syria.) ³ All returned to their own ancestral towns to register for this census. ⁴ And because Joseph was a descendant of King David, he had to go to Bethlehem in Judea, David's ancient home. He traveled there from the village of Nazareth in Galilee. ⁵ He took with him Mary, to whom he was engaged, and was expecting a child.

⁶ And while they were there, the time came for her baby to be born. ⁷ She gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him snugly in strips of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no lodging available for them.

⁸ That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. ⁹ Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, ¹⁰ but the angel reassured them. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "<u>I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people</u>. ¹¹ The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! ¹² And you will recognize him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger."

¹³ Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying,

¹⁴ "Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased."

HOW JESUS GETS US

1. He <u>CONNECTS</u> with our feelings.

"Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood...<u>he had to enter into every detail of human life</u>. Then, when he came before God as high priest...he would have <u>already experienced it all himself</u>—all the pain, all the testing—and would be able to help where help was needed." (Hebrews 2:14a, 17–18, NLT/MSG)

"The one who formed their hearts understands everything they do." (Psalm 33:15, GW)

"[Lord], you've kept track of my every toss and turn through the sleepless nights, Each tear entered in your ledger, each ache written in your book." (Psalm 56:8, The Message)

2. He CALMS our fears.

"the angel reassured them. "Don't be afraid!" (Luke 2:10, NLT)

3. He <u>COVERS</u> our failure.

"...For <u>only as a human being could he die</u>, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. <u>Only in this way could he set free all who have lived</u>..." (Hebrews 2:14–15, NLT)
