³⁵ As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind beggar was sitting beside the road. ³⁶ When he heard the noise of a crowd going past, he asked what was happening. ³⁷ They told him that Jesus the Nazarene was going by. ³⁸ So he began shouting, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" ³⁹ "Be quiet!" the people in front yelled at him.

But he only shouted louder, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

⁴⁰ When Jesus heard him, he stopped and ordered that the man be brought to him. As the man came near, Jesus asked him, ⁴¹ "What do you want me to do for you?"

"Lord," he said, "I want to see!"

⁴² And Jesus said, "All right, receive your sight! Your faith has healed you." ⁴³ Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus, praising God. And all who saw it praised God, too. Luke 18:35–43 (NLT)

When Praying for a Miracle...

1. Be PASSIONATE.

"He <u>cried out</u>, "Jesus! Son of David! Take pity on me!" (Luke 18:38, GNB)

"so he began *shouting*..." (Luke 18:38, The Living Bible)

"You will seek me and find me, when you seek me <u>with all your heart</u>." (Jeremiah 29:13, ESV)

2. Be PERSISTENT.

"The people in front scolded him and told him to be quiet. But he shouted <u>even more</u> <i>loudly, *"Son of David! Take pity on me!"" (Luke 18:39, GNB)*

"God did not keep back his own Son, but he gave him for us. If God did this, <u>won't he freely</u> <u>give us everything else</u>?" (Romans 8:32, CEV)

"Don't be weary in prayer; <u>keep at it</u>; watch for God's answers, and remember to be thankful when they come." (Colossians 4:2, The Living Bible)

3. Be PRECISE.

"So Jesus stopped and ordered the blind man to be brought to him. When he came near, Jesus asked him, "<u>What do you want me to do for you</u>?" "Sir," he answered, "I want to see again." (Luke 18:40–41, GNB)

"...the reason you don't have what you want is that <u>you don't ask God</u> for it." (James 4:2, The Living Bible)

4. Be **POSITIVE**.

"Jesus said to him, "Then see! Your *faith* has made you well." (Luke 18:42, GNB)

"Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, <u>believe that you have received it</u>, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:24, NIV)

"And this same God who takes care of me will supply <u>all your needs</u> from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19, NLT)

5. Be PRAISEFUL.

"At once he was able to see, and he <u>followed</u> Jesus, <u>giving thanks</u> to God. When the crowd saw it, they all <u>praised</u> God." (Luke 18:43, GNB)

"Don't worry about anything, but in all your prayers ask God for what you need, always asking him with a *thankful heart*." (Philippians 4:6, GNB)
